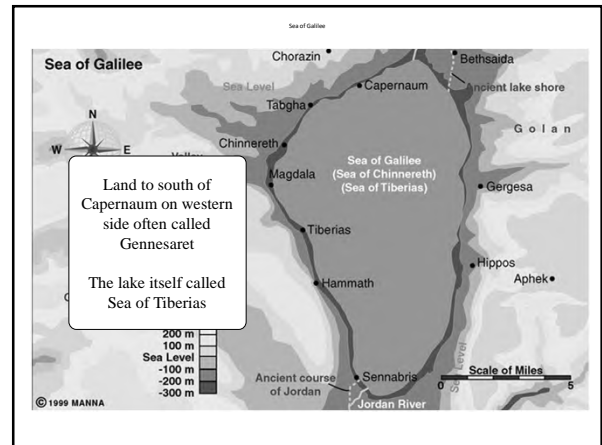
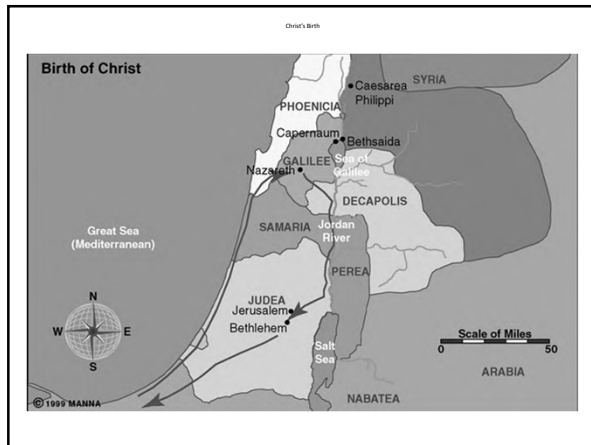

- Setting: Lake of Gennesaret (Sea of Galilee)



## Amazing Results!



- Great number of fish
- Filled net – began to break
- Filled two boats – both began to sink

### Call of the First Disciples

- Setting: Lake of Gennesaret (Sea of Galilee)
- As crowd presses – he enters a boat to teach (v. 3)
- Peter & fishing partners – washing nets after an unsuccessful night (v. 2)
- Tells Peter to launch into deep & cast net (v. 4)

- Peter reacts with deep humility (vv.8-9)
- Disciples forsook all and followed (vv. 10-11)

1. *Fished all night – caught nothing*
2. *They are professional fishermen – what does a carpenter know?*
3. *This was early in process of calling his disciples – yet Peter has seen enough to have a strong faith!*

A. Request of Jesus seemed unreasonable

B. It is not our place to question & doubt


1. *Jer. 10:23*
2. *Isa. 55:8-9*
3. *Prov. 16:25*
4. *Rom. 11:34*
5. *It is ours to believe and do*
  - He is creator – we are creatures
  - He is God – we are men
  - He is Lord – we are his servants

**Obey**  
Even If Seems Unreasonable



- A. Request of Jesus seemed unreasonable
- B. It is not our place to question & doubt
- C. Bible characters were asked to do what seems unreasonable
  1. *Believe would have a son in old age (Rom. 4:17-ff)*
  2. *Sacrifice son (Gen. 22)*
  3. *Separate from wives (Ezra 10)*
  4. *Dip seven times (2 Kings 5)*

- A. Request of Jesus seemed unreasonable
- B. It is not our place to question & doubt
- C. Bible characters were asked to do what seems unreasonable
- D. God asks us to do what seems unreasonable
  1. *Baptized (Mark 16:16)*
  2. *Divorce for only one cause (Matt. 19:9)*
  3. *Not forsake under distress (Heb. 10:25)*
  4. *Withdraw from disorderly (2 Thess. 3)*
  5. *Forgive if repent (Luke 17:1-5)*

**Try**  
Even If Seems Impossible




- A. Peter must have thought about failure
  1. *Fished all night – caught nothing*
  2. *“Nevertheless” suggests he was going to act CONTRARY to how things look*
  3. *He acts solely on faith in Jesus!*
  4. *Going to try – in spite of:*
    - Failure of the night
    - Possible failure of the future
  5. *By trying he caught fish – would not have happened otherwise!*
  6. *If he had not TRIED – he would have failed (as fisherman & disciple)*

**Try**  
Even If Seems Impossible



- A. Peter must have thought about failure
- B. We must try to do what we are afraid we will fail in
  1. *Living the Christian life*
  2. *Bringing others to Christ*
  3. *Correct & restrain children*
  4. *Teaching effort (radio, bulletin, etc.)*
  5. *Teaching a class / taking part in service*
  6. *Forgiving*
  7. *Try to be mate should be*

**Try**  
Even If Seems Impossible



- A. Peter must have thought about failure
- B. We must try to do what we are afraid we will fail in
- C. One talent man failed saying, “I was afraid” (Matt. 25:25)

## Continue On Even If Weary



A. Peter & other fishermen were tired

1. *Toiled all night (v. 5)*
2. *Things had not gone as hoped*
3. *Disappointed – discouraged*
4. *Seems like all done was useless*
5. *If ever thought of quitting – this is the time!*
6. *Yet – Jesus said keep fishing!*

## Continue On Even If Weary




A. Peter & other fishermen were tired

B. Easy to become weary - discouraged

1. *Life doesn't go as planned*
2. *Face unexpected difficulties*
3. *Try & seems get knocked down!*
4. *May be weary with self – lack of progress*
5. *May be weary with family – lack of cooperation – faithfulness, etc.*
6. *May be weary with those try influence – no fruit*

## Continue On Even If Weary



A. Peter & other fishermen were tired

B. Easy to become weary – discouraged

C. The weary, tired and discouraged must continue on

1. Point of Hebrews 10-13
  - 10:23, 35-36, 39
  - 12:1, 12
2. *1 Cor. 15:58*
3. *Gal. 6:7-9*
4. *Don't ever quit – launch back out into the deep!*

## Humble Even If it is Hard




A. Humility may not have been real easy for Peter

1. *Disciples argued about who is the greatest (Matt. 18:1ff)*
2. *Confidence in himself – always seems to first to speak or answer (i.e. Mt. 26:31-33)*
3. *Confidence to act – cut off Malchus' ear (Jno. 18:10)*
4. *Claimed he would never stumble or deny Christ (Matt. 26:31-33)*

## Humble

Even If it  
is Hard




A. Humility may not have been real easy for Peter

B. Peter humbly bowed before Jesus

1. Reason: *astonished at his power (v. 9)*
2. Reaction: *Conscious of his own unworthiness to be in his presence (v. 8)*
3. *Peter had seen other miracles (cf. Luke 4), but this was a turning point!*
4. *Jesus sought to calm his fears (v. 10) – fear /anxiety must turn to love and respect*

## Humble

Even If it  
is Hard



A. Humility may not have been real easy for Peter

B. Peter humbly bowed before Jesus

C. God calls us to be humble

1. *Call to be humble (Matt. 18:3-4; 1 Pet. 5:5-6)*
2. *Times it may be hard*
  - When think better (Luke 18:9-14)
  - When think valuable (Matt. 18:1-4)
  - When think stronger (Gal. 6:1-3)
  - When think know more (1 Cor. 8:1-2)

## Forsake All

Even If it is  
Important




A. Jesus called upon them to be disciples which demanded them to forsake....

1. *Left business & boats*
  - Wasn't much – but all had!
  - When they had best day ever!
2. *Left family (Matt. 4:22; Mark 1:20)*
3. *Left ALL!*
4. *Reason: Who they followed, what they became & what doing far exceeded...*
5. *Forsaking / Leaving was immediate – not days later!*

1. *Lord should always come first*
  - Matt. 6:33
  - 1 Pet. 3:15
  - Matt. 19:16-31
