- <u>Worldly pleasures</u>. (2 Thessalonians 2:12; Hebrews 11:24-25; 2 Timothy 3:4)
- -<u>Worldly riches</u>. (1 Timothy 6:9-10; Luke 12:16-21; 1 Timothy 6:19)
- -<u>Worldly cares</u>. (Luke 8:14; Luke 14:15ff)

#### Are You Fit For The Kingdom?

#### "Is Fit For The Kingdom Of God." 2 Peter 2:20-22

-Christ gave Himself for the church. Ephesians 5:25-27, "Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself up for it ... that he might present the church to himself a glorious (church), not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish."
