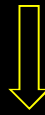

Characteristics of N.T. Baptism

- Requires Water.
Acts 10:47, "Can anyone forbid water, that these should not be baptized. . ."
Acts 8:36, "See, here is water. What hinders me from being baptized?"
- Requires Much Water. *John 3:23*
- Requires Going Down Into & Coming Up Out Of Water. *Acts 8:38-39*
- Requires A Burial. *Rom. 6:4*

Characteristics of N.T. Baptism

- For Salvation – *Mk. 16:16*
- Now Saves Us – *1 Pet. 3:21*
- Into Christ's Death – *Rom. 6:3*
- For Remission Of Sins – *Acts 2:38*
- For Washing Away Sin – *Acts 22:16*
- Body Of Sin Done Away – *Rom. 6:6*
- To Be Born Again – *John 3:5*

Characteristics of N.T. Baptism

- Necessary to entrance into the kingdom.
 - *John 3:5*
- Raised with Christ.
 - *Colossians 2:11-12*
- Results in putting on Christ.
 - *Gal. 3:27*
- Raised to walk in new life.
 - *Rom. 6:4*
- Made alive to God in Christ.
 - *Rom. 6:11*

Characteristics Of N.T. Baptism

- Puts One Into Christ
 - *Galatians 3:27*, "For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ."
 - Adds One To Christ's Church
 - *Acts 2:47*. "praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved." (NKJV)
- "Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them" (2:41)

Characteristics of N.T. Baptism

- Corinthians were baptized into Christ after hearing and believing (Acts 18:8; cf. 1 Cor. 6:11)
- **Into One Body**
 - *1 Corinthians 12:13*,
"For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, whether bond or free. . ."

Mt. 28:19 Acts 2:41, 47 Gal.3:27-28

- In Christ...
 - All spiritual blessings, *Eph. 1:3*
 - Redemption, *Eph. 1:7*
 - Forgiveness, *Eph. 1:7*
 - Inheritance, *Eph. 1:11*
 - New creature, *2 Cor. 5:17*
 - Salvation, *2 Tim. 2:10*
 - No condemnation, *Rom. 8:1*
 - Eternal life, *1 John 5:11-12*
