Believers In God

TEXT: 1 Peter 1:13 - 2:5

INTRODUCTION:

- A. CHRISTIANS DISTINGUISHED BY FAITH, HENCE "BELIEVERS IN GOD."
- B. TEXT REVEALS CHARACTERISTICS OF "BELIEVERS IN GOD."

I. ONE WHO "GIRDS UP HIS LOINS" - IS PREPARED (verse 13).

- A. HE IS SOBER, *nepho*-"1) to be sober, to be calm and collected in spirit 2) to be temperate, to be dispassionate, to be circumspect." Take it seriously (1 Peter 5:8).
- B. HIS HOPE IS SET ON JESUS (Colossians 3:1-2).

II. A CHILD OF OBEDIENCE (verses 13-16).

- A. NOT THE SAME AS IN THE TIMES OF THEIR IGNORANCE.
 - 1. Change demanded by God (Acts 17:30).
 - 2. Former lusts must lose their hold (Romans 6:17).
- B. HE IS HOLY (**Titus 2:13-14; 2 Corinthians 7:1**).

III. CALLS ON GOD AS FATHER (verse 17). A CHILD OF GOD.

- A. NOT EVERYONE IS A SPIRITUAL CHILD OF GOD (John 8:44).
- B. IN ORDER TO BE A CHILD OF GOD, ONE MUST BE BEGOTTEN OF GOD (1 Peter 1:3, 13).
- C. NOTICE THAT A CHILD OF GOD IS LIKE GOD (1 John 3:1-3; Ephesians 5:1-2).
- D. THIS ALLOWS US TO BE JOINT WITH CHRIST (Romans 8:16-17).

IV. ONE WHO HAS BEEN REDEEMED BY BLOOD (verses 18-21).

- A. ALL HAVE SINNED (Romans 3:23) AND DESERVE DEATH (Romans 6:23).
- B. BY THE BLOOD REDEEMED. *lutroo*-"to redeem, to liberate by payment of ransom" **Thayer**.
- C. JESUS GAVE HIS BLOOD IN OUR PLACE (Matthew 20:28; 2 Corinthians 5:14-15).
- D. HIS BLOOD CLEANSES US OF OUR SIN (1 John 1:7).

V. <u>HAS PURIFIED HIS SOUL IN OBEDIENCE</u> (verse 22).

- A. THE TRUTH IS FOUND IN THE TEACHING OF JESUS (John 17:17; 8:32).
- B. THE NECESSITY OF OBEDIENCE (Hebrews 5:8-9).
- C. OBEDIENCE BRINGS ABOUT CLEANSING (1 Peter 3:21).

VI. BEGOTTEN AGAIN THROUGH THE WORD (verses 23-25).

- A. THE WORD PRODUCES FAITH IN THE HEARER (Romans 10:17).
- B. FAITH IS PERFECTED IN OBEDIENCE (James 2:21-24).
- C. AS PHYSICAL BEGETTAL IS CONSUMMATED BY PHYSICAL BIRTH, SPIRITUAL BEGETTAL IS BY SPIRITUAL BIRTH (John 3:5).
