"The turning point for better or worse..." "The decisive moment." (Webster)

Turning Point For Cain

>"If thou doest well, shall it not be lifted up?" ("Shalt thou not be accepted?"KJV).

"If thou doest not well, sin coucheth at the door; and unto thee shall be its desire, but do thou rule over it." (Verse 7)

- •Saul's reason for his disobedience ... "The people" 1 Samuel 15:21
- •Saul disobeyed. 1 Samuel 15:22-23
- •God meant WHAT He said. cf. 1 Samuel 15:26: 32-33

Crisis Comes At The Point Of ENDURANCE.

Joshua and Caleb Numbers 14

- •Joshua's challenge. Joshua 24:15
- •"Caleb hath followed me fully" (Numbers 14:24)
 - •He followed in the land of Canaan, 45 years later. Joshua 14:8-10

Crisis Comes At The Point Of ENDURANCE.

- •Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach & Abed-nego. Daniel 1–3
- •Nehemiah.
- •Job James 5:7-11

Crisis Comes At The Point Of – LOVE.

- •Love for God. Matthew 22:36ff; cf. Deuteronomy 6:5; 1 John 2:3-5
- •Love of the truth. 2 Thessalonians 2:10; Proverbs 23:23; Psalms 119

Crisis Comes At The Point Of – LOVE.

Two kinds of pressure that create this crisis:

- •Pressure on the mind to believe wrong things. 2 Corinthians 10:5; 2 Peter 2.
- •Pressure of the flesh to do wrong things. Genesis 6; Romans 13:13; 1 Corinthians 6; Galatians 5; Ephesians 4; Colossians 3; 1 Thessalonians 4:3-7; 1 Peter 2, 4

Crisis Comes At The Point Of – LOVE.

- •Can't stop loving the truth because the pressure is on.
 - •Church at Ephesus did. Revelation 2:1-4
 - •People of Jesus' day did. John 6:66
 - •Demas did. 2 Timothy 4:10; Colossians 4:14; Philemon 24
