Context: Great Commission.

Matthew 28:19-20, “Go ye therefore, and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit: teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I commanded you: and lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world.”

“Go Make Disciples”

Definition: “Disciple.”

- ◆ “*matheteuo* to be a disciple or follower of another’s doctrine (Matt 27:57); to make a disciple (Matt 28:19; Acts 14:21); to instruct (Matt 13:52) with the purpose of making a disciple ...
- ◆ “*matheteuo* means not only to learn, but to become attached to one’s teacher and to become his follower in doctrine and conduct of life.” (The Complete Word Study Dictionary)

“Go Make Disciples”

The Goal Of Discipleship.

- ◆ Stated by Jesus Himself: to be like the teacher. Luke 6:40; cf. Romans 8:29; Galatians 4:19

What Is A Disciple?

- ◆ One who abides in the words of Jesus.
John 8:31; Matthew 7:21ff; James 1:21-25
- ◆ One who loves the brethren. John 13:34-35
- ◆ One who bears much fruit. John 15:5, 8;
cf. Matthew 5:13-16

The Costs Of Discipleship

What Is A Disciple?

- ◇ Jesus must come first. Luke 14:26
 - Before family. Matthew 10:34-37
 - Before self. Luke 9:23-25
- ◇ Must be willing to suffer. Luke 14:27; 2 Timothy 3:12
- ◇ Renounce all that we have to follow Jesus. Luke 14:33; cf. John 6

Sacrifice

The Rewards Of Discipleship

- ◇ Future blessings. Romans 5:9; cf. Romans 6:23; 11:22
- ◇ Present blessings.
 - ◇ Forgiveness. Acts 2:38
 - ◇ Prayer. John 9:31; 1 Peter 3:12
 - ◇ Peace. Philippians 4:4ff; 1 Peter 5:6
 - ◇ Family. Galatians 3:26ff; Romans 8:16-17

The Beginning Of Discipleship

“Go make disciples.” TEACH

- **God calls the lost through teaching.**
John 6:44-45; Romans 10:8-13, 14-17;
Note: Acts 16:9-10
- **Make Disciples by Gospel Preaching.**
Acts 2:14, 22, 36, 40; 2 Thessalonians 2:14
- **Preaching saves believers.**
1 Corinthians 1:21; Romans 10:14-17

The Beginning Of Discipleship

“Go make disciples.” TEACH

- Acts 2:42, *“And they continued steadfastly in the apostles’ teaching and fellowship, in the breaking of bread and the prayers.”*
- Acts 5:25, *“And there came one and told them, Behold, the men whom ye put in the prison are in the temple standing and teaching the people.”*
- Acts 5:28, *“... saying, We strictly charged you not to teach in this name: and behold, ye have filled Jerusalem with your teaching, and intend to bring this man’s blood upon us.”*
- Acts 13:12, *“Then the proconsul, when he saw what was done, believed, being astonished at the teaching of the Lord.”*

The Beginning Of Discipleship

- Acts 15:35, *“But Paul and Barnabas tarried in Antioch, teaching and preaching the word of the Lord, with many others also.”*
- Acts 17:19, *“And they took hold of him, and brought him unto the Areopagus, saying, May we know what this new teaching is, which is spoken by thee?”*
- Acts 18:11, *“And he dwelt (there) a year and six months, teaching the word of God among them.”*
- Acts 20:20, *“... how I shrank not from declaring unto you anything that was profitable, and teaching you publicly, and from house to house” (cf. 19:8ff, 20)*
- Acts 28:31, *“preaching the kingdom of God, and teaching the things concerning the Lord Jesus Christ with all boldness, none forbidding him.”*

The Beginning Of Discipleship

“Go make disciples.” TEACH

- ◇ Choice of masters (disciple). Acts 11:26, 21 (“Lord”), 23.
- ◇ Choice of conduct. cf. 1 Peter 4:1-5
- ◇ **Repentance Must Occur. Acts 11:18**
- ◇ Radical change in life because:
 - ◇ Must die to sin. Galatians 2:20.

Choice. cf. Romans 6:16-18

The Beginning Of Discipleship

TEACH – Disciples are **NOT** Made by the Gospels of Men: cf. Matthew 15:7-9

1. Social gospel: Converted to recreation and social activities.
2. Ecumenical gospel: Unity in moral and doctrinal diversity is sin. (**Galatians 1:8-9; 2 John 9-11**)
3. Denominational gospels: Faith only, universalism, etc.
4. Latter-day gospels: LDS, JW's, Adventists, Premillennial, etc. ¹³

The Beginning Of Discipleship

“Go make disciples.” BAPTIZE THEM!

Water Baptism is Essential:

- ◆ For a relationship with God. Matthew 28:19; (Galatians 3:27)
- ◆ For salvation. Mark 16:16; (1 Peter 3:21)
- ◆ For remission of sins. Acts 2:38
- ◆ For cleansing. Acts 22:16; Ephesians 5:26 ¹⁴
- ◆ For new life in Christ. Romans 6:3-4

The Beginning Of Discipleship

“Go make disciples.” TEACHING THEM ...
(Those you have baptized)

- ◆ Bible teaching and learning is to a new Christian what milk is to a new baby.
1 Peter 2:2; cf. Acts 2:41, 46; 5:12, 42
- ◆ God measures spiritual strength and maturity by our interest in, our commitment to, and our growth in learning and living God's word. ¹⁵
Hebrews 5:11-12

Are You A Disciple?

- ◆ One who **seeks** to be like Christ.
- ◆ One who **abides** in His word.
- ◆ One who **loves** the brethren.
- ◆ One who **bears** much fruit.
- ◆ One who **puts Jesus first**, no matter the cost.
- ◆ One who **enjoys the blessings and shares in the responsibilities** of being in Christ. ¹⁶
