Paul's history from Jerusalem to Rome

- Been falsely accused—Acts 21:27f
- Arrested
- Mobbed – Acts 22:22
- Threatened with scourging – Acts 22:23-25
- Escorted by 470 soldiers to Felix – Acts 23:23-24
- Accused before Felix – Acts 24:1-22
- Left two years in bonds – Acts 24:27
- Tried again before Festus – Acts 25:1-9
- Forced to appeal to Caesar to save his life – Acts 25:11
- Tried before king Agrippa – Acts 26
- Sent to Rome to be tried before Caesar – Acts 27-28
