The Basis Of His Concern For The Lost (Acts 20)

- He regarded himself as a servant of the Lord. Verse 19
 - Past work in Ephesus as a servant. Ephesians 3:7-9
 - Paul frequently referred to himself as a "Bondservant." Philippians 1:1; Romans 1:1; cf. 1 Corinthians 9:19

The Basis Of His Concern For The Lost (Acts 20)

- He regarded himself as a servant.
- Essential to saving the lost.
 - Jesus set the example. Matthew 20:28; Philippians 2:5-7
 - Christians called to serve. Matthew 20:26; Matthew 18:1ff; Romans 12:3; Hebrews 10:24

Characteristics Of Paul's Service Acts 20:19

- Paul's service was...
- Humble. "With all lowliness of mind." Ephesians 4:1; Philippians 3:5-8; Galatians 6:14
- Tearful. "And with Leaf S. of others: 31; 2 Corinthians 2:4 Jesus. Luke 19:41 Samuel. 1 Samuel 15

 Blasphemy. Acts 19:20:1-3
 Idolatry. Acts 19:28

Characteristics Of Paul's Service Acts 20:19

- Paul's service was...
- **Trying**. "And with trials." 2 Corinthians 11:23-28; cf. Acts 14:11-19; 2 Timothy 1:8; 4:5; 3:12
- Labored with his hands. Acts 20:34; 2 Corinthians 12:15
- Anxiety. 2 Corinthians 11:28
- **Rewarding.** Acts 19:9-10; 1 Thessalonians 2:19-20; Philippians 4:1; Philippians 1:21; 3 John 4

The Extent Of Paul's Concern For The Lost

- He went to the lost. (Went to Ephesus twice.) cf. John 4:34-35; Matthew 9:36-38; Philippians 4:16
- Taught fearlessly. "I shrank not from declaring to you..." Verse 26; Ezekiel
- Taught "Publicly and from house to house." cf. 1 Corinthians 9:16; 2 Timothy 4:2
