

PLEASING GOD

Hebrews 11:5-6, "By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and he was not found, because God translated him: for he hath had witness borne to him that before his translation **he had been well-pleasing unto God**: (cf. Genesis 5:21-24) And without faith it is impossible to be **well-pleasing** (unto him); for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and (that) he is a rewarder of them that seek after him."

2 Corinthians 5:8-9,
 "We are of good courage, I say, and are willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be at home with the Lord. **Wherefore also WE make it our aim, whether at home or absent, to be well-pleasing unto him.**"

1 Corinthians 10:5,
 "Howbeit **with most of them God was not well pleased**: for they were overthrown in the wilderness."

PLEASING GOD ...

1 Thessalonians 2:14-16,
 "For ye, brethren, became imitators of the churches of God which are in Judaea in Christ Jesus: for ye also suffered the same things of your own countrymen, even as they did of the Jews; **who both killed the Lord Jesus and the prophets, and drove out us, and pleased not God**, and are contrary to all men; forbidding us to speak to the Gentiles that they may be saved; to fill up their sins always: but the wrath is come upon them to the uttermost." (cf. Acts 17:1ff)

2 Corinthians 10:18,
 "For **not he that commendeth himself is approved**, but whom the Lord commendeth."

PLEASING GOD ...

Ephesians 5:7-10,
*"Be not ye therefore partakers with them; For ye were once darkness, but are now light in the Lord: walk as children of light (for the fruit of the light is in all goodness and righteousness and truth), proving what is **well-pleasing unto the Lord.**"*

PLEASING GOD ...

Colossians 1:9-10,
"For this cause we also, since the day we heard (it), do not cease to pray and make request for you,
 1. *that ye may be filled with the knowledge of his will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding,*
 2. *to walk worthily of the Lord **unto all pleasing,***
 3. *bearing fruit in every good work, and*
 4. *increasing in the knowledge of God."*

Luke 2:12-14,
*"And this (is) the sign unto you: Ye shall find a babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, and lying in a manger. And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, Glory to God in the highest, And on earth peace among men **in whom he is well pleased.**"*

*"Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, we have boldness toward God; and whatsoever we ask we receive of him, **because we keep his commandments and do the things that are pleasing in his sight.**"*

- Don't assume you naturally know what God wants. Proverbs 14:12
- Through knowledge we can please Him. Colossians 1:9-10; cf. 1 Corinthians 2:10ff
