- The one you're not keeping! Luke 18:18-23
- There are "weightier" provisions of God's word. Matthew 23:23
- Jesus said it was: "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart ... all your soul ... all your mind ... and all your strength."

Love God with all of our heart, soul, strength and mind.

 First note that our relationship with God is above all else. Before we can worry about our relationship with anyone else, we must begin with our relationship with God. 1 John 1:3

All Our Heart – Emotionally

Undivided loyalty and affection
God's call for service with a whole heart.

1 Chronicles 28:9; 1 Kings 8:61; 2 Kings 20:3
A lack of undivided interest

1 Kings 11:4; 15:3; 2 Kings 14:3-4
Paul sought "undistracted devotion."
1 Corinthians 7:35
Need to be aware when our heart goes after other things.
