 - 1. He has dealt with the great hope that sustains us.
 - 2. He has told us how to prepare.
 - 3. And given instructions how to live before others (2:9, 11-12).
- B. INSTRUCTIONS NOT GIVEN TO HELP AVOID TRIAL IT WILL COME!
- C. HOW WILL WE "GIVE ANSWER?" HOW CAN WE?
- I. "<u>BE ZEALOUS OF THAT WHICH IS GOOD</u>" (verse 13).
- A. GOD ACKNOWLEDGES RIGHT IN US (verse12; 1 John 3:7, 10; Acts 10:34-35).
- B. RIGHTEOUSNESS IS OUR ID MARK (2 Timothy 2:19).
- C. BUSY YOURSELF OUR PREOCCUPATION (Titus 2:14; 3:1).
- D. Romans 8:31; Philippians 4:13; 1 Peter 3:12-13.

- A. THE LAST ENEMY (**Hebrews 9:27**).
 - 1. Sorrow and hopelessness (1 Thessalonians 4:13; John 11:32-35, 39).
 - 2. Bondage (Hebrews 2:14).
- B. DIE FOR RIGHTEOUSNESS SAKE? (Matthew 10:28; 1 Peter 1:3).

III. "SANCTIFY IN YOUR HEARTS CHRIST AS LORD" (verse 15).

A. DECIDE JESUS IS THE BOSS! (Colossians 3:17).

B. A COMMITMENT IS REQUIRED!

- 1. Jesus' example (2:21-24; 4:1-2).
- 2. We have already decided! (4:19).
- C. WE MUST BE READY TO SET ASIDE ALL DISTRACTIONS (Hebrews 12:1-2; Matthew 6:24).

 - 1. Are we ready to pay it?
 - 2. It is worth everything (1 Peter 3:17; Matthew 5:10-12; Romans 8:18; 1 Corinthians 6:20).
