History of King David

David a hero by God's standard.

- •Jehovah's anointed as King. 1 Sam. 16:6-13
- •David's faith conquered his fear. 1 Sam. 17:26ff
 - Saul offered a reward. 1 Sam. 17:25
 - David's confidence in the Lord. 1 Sam. 17:36ff
 - David received the promise. 2 Sam. 7:12-16
 - A man after God's own heart. Acts 13:22
 - Man of faith. Heb. 11:32-34

David's Mistakess Faith Vs. Pride

- Pride
 - •Pride caused him to number the people.

 After war with the Philistines. 1 Chron. 21:1
 - God displeased and smote the people (1 Chron 21:7)...Consequences 70,000 died. 2 Sam. 24:1
- David repented. 2 Sam. 24:10; 1 Chron. 21:16

David's Mistakes Faith Vs. Anxiety

- Anxiety.
 - •Many hated him. Ps. 69:4
 - •Saul. 1 Sam. 18:10; 19:2,9; 20:1-3
 - •Pursues David 1 Sam. Ch. 23-24
 - •Absalom, his son rebelled. 2 Sam. 15:12 2 Sam. 19 (note: 2 Sam. 18:5, 29ff)
- •David overcame his anxiety.
 - •Heb. 13:6; quote from...Ps. 118:6
 - •1 Pet. 5:7; quote from... Ps. 55:22

David's Mistakes Faith Vs. Revenge

- Revenge.
 - •David wanted to kill Nabal. 1 Sam. 25:2ff, 13, 21-25
- •David overcame his revenge.
 - •Allowed King Saul to live.
 - 1 Sam. 24-25 (En-gedi); cf. 1 Sam. 26:9-10 (Ziph)
 - •Allowed Nabal to live. 1 Sam. 25:32-33

David's Mistakes Faith Vs. Lust

- •Lust. 2 Sam. 11
 - •Idleness (1-2); Evil thoughts (2-3); Coveting his neighbor's wife (3-4); Adultery (4); Lying & deceit (6-13); Murder (14-17); Hypocrisy (25)
 - Caused enemies of Jehovah to blaspheme.
 - 2 Sam. 12:14
- David overcame his lust.
 - •Nathan's rebuke. 2 Sam. 12:1-6,
 - •David repents. 2 Sam. 12:13; cf. Ps. 51:1ff
 - •Note what David says about rebellion. Ps. 32:3-5, 9-10

David's Mistakes Faith Vs. Despair

- Despair.
 - •Child dies. 2 Sam. 12:10-23
 - •Amnon rapes Tamar. 2 Sam. 13:1-14
 - •Absalom kills Amnon. 2 Sam. 13:32-33
 - •Absalom rebels against David. 2 Sam. 15:13-14, 30-31; 16:6: 17:24
 - •Absalom is killed, David is crushed. 2 Sam. 18:33
- David overcame despair. 2 Sam. 12:24; 2 Sam. 18:1-8

- > Faith Vs. Fear
 - ➤ We need to be men of courage today.

 Mt. 10:28; Rev. 21:8

Lessons To Be Learned:

- Faith Vs. Pride
 - ➤ Ps 8:3-4 "When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which thou hast ordained; What is man, that thou art mindful of him? And the son of man, that thou visitest him?" cf. Ps. 33:16-18
 - >Rom. 12:3; 1 Cor. 1:25; Mt. 18:3; Jms. 4:6,10

- > Application: Lesson On Patience
- > Faith Vs. Revenge
 - ➤ David lived under the O.T. law of God. "Vengeance is mine, and recompense, At the time when their foot shall slide: For the day of their calamity is at hand, And the things that are to come upon them shall make haste. For Jehovah will judge his people" (Deut 32:35-36)
 - ➤ We live under the N.T. law of God. "Avenge not yourselves, beloved, but give place unto the wrath (of God): for it is written, Vengeance belongeth unto me; I will recompense, saith the Lord" (Rom 12:19; cf. Mt. 6:38-39)
