
The Savior's Invitation

- He had gone out into the wilderness to be tempted and returned victoriously. Matthew 4.
- He was one that could deliver!

Who Is Included In This Invitation?

- Everyone that is weary, and conscious of being heavily laden, Christ said, "Come ... I will give you rest." "Whosoever" cf. Acts 2:21
 - One who is away. Isaiah 59:1-2
 - One who has departed.
 MEN are to be persuaded. 2 Corinthians 5:11
 - Ephesians 3:3

The Savior's Invitation

Those invited have to ability to accept the invitation.

• Choice. John 5:39-40 Some "will not" come. cf. Matthew 23:37 "Ye would not ..."

cf. Matthew 25:40-46 Judgment ... "Ye did it not ..."

cf. Rev. 22:17 "he that will ..."

The Savior's Invitation

One's Condition Will Be Much Better If They Accept The Savior's Invitation.

- Cruel to invite one to "Come" if it was of no benefit.
- Promised "REST."
 - Forgiveness.
 - Eternal rest.
 - Hebrews 4:1-3
