# **Importance Of Unity**

Jesus prayed for unity. John 17:20-23.

1. Jesus prayed for that which is possible.

2. cf. Mark 3:24 "And if a kingdom be divided against itself, that kingdom cannot stand." cf. Luke 11:17

#### **Importance Of Unity**

- Paul demanded unity among the brethren at <u>Corinth</u>.
- 1 Corinthians 1:10-11; cf. 1 Corinthians 3:1-3.
- 1. Division is ugly, wrong and sinful.
- 2. The Lord recognizes no cause for division as just, except truth. Peace must not be bought at the expense of compromise of truth. cf. Matthew 10:34-39.
- 3. The real danger is from within. cf. Acts. 20:29-30 cf. Hymenaeus and Philetus who taught the resurrection was past. 2 Timothy 2:15-18

# **Importance Of Unity**

- <u>God hates division</u>. cf. Proverbs 6:16 "Six things God hates, yea seven ... A false witness that uttereth lies, and he that soweth discord among brethren."
- 1. Division is condemned. Galatians 5:19-20; Romans 2:8; James 3:13-18

# Jesus' Prayer For Unity. John 17:9-21

- Jesus knew what was to happen to him as "the hour is come." Verse 1 cf. Psalms 22; 1 Peter 1:11
- 1. Though the Holy Spirit was given to the apostles (John 16:13), Jesus knew they would soon pass through the fiery trial. cf. Matthew 26:31.

#### Jesus' Prayer For Unity. John 17:9-21

- Note the unity that existed among his chosen disciples.
- 1. Verse 6 they were called out of the world and given to Christ.
- 2. Verse 8 they were given "words."
  - a. They "received" the message and "they have believed that thou didst send me" and "they have kept thy word."

#### Jesus' Prayer For Unity. John 17:9-21

- The unity among the disciples about to be tested. John 17:11-19 Jesus prayed ...
- 1. Keep them though thine own name. verse 11
- 2. That they may be one. verse 11
- 3. That they might have my joy. verses 13-14
- 4. Keep them from the evil one. verse 15
- 5. Sanctify them. verse 17
  - a. These were to be set apart from the world, unto God's purpose. BUT HOW?
  - b. "Through thy truth: thy word is truth."

# Jesus' Prayer For Unity. John 17:9-21

This unity would be created among all those whowould believe"THROUGH THEIR WORD."Verses 20-21

- 1. These would all be one.
- 2. This glorious unity was IN CHRIST , WITH God, AMONG believers, UPON the WORD OF GOD.
- 3. The love of God is seen in this divine plan. Verses 22-26.
- 4. This is consistent with John 6:56, 63; 14:15, 20-21.

### The Reality Of Unity

Holy Spirit reveals the word to the Apostles. Acts 1:3, 4-5; cf. John 14:26; 15:26-27; 16:13-14

- 1. Word preached. Acts 2:14-21 a. "What shall we do?" Verse 37
  - b. Forgiveness offered. Verse 38
- 2. Word received. Acts 2:41; cf. 1 John 1:3-4
- 3. Obedient added (united). Acts 2:47
- 4. Word perpetuated. "Continued steadfastly ..." Acts 2:42
