 - Spiritual blessings, the Blessediare the dead Religition 14:13 Proverbs 28:9
 The Promise of Heaven, Joh Savation, 2 Timothy 2:10
 Thessalonians 1:7-10; JohNew Greature, 2 Corinthians 5:17
 - Grace. Romans 5

Wearing The Name "Christian" Means...

- The RESPONSIBILITY of wearing the name.
 - Disciple. Acts 11:26
 - Persuaded. Acts 26:28
 - Suffer / Glorify. 1 Peter 4:16
 - Life of Duty. Ecclesiastes 12:13; Luke 17:7-10

Difference Between Being A Christian And Wearing The Name

- Strong and weak. Romans 15:1; Ephesians 6:10
- Spiritual and carnal. 1 Corinthians 3:1; Galatians
- Hot and cold. Revelation 3:15
- Stable and unstable. Ephesians 4:14-16
- Close and afar. cf. Matthew 26:58

Difference between being saved or lost! cf. Hebrews 10:32-36; 2 Peter 2:20-22

Difference Between Being A

Christian And Wearing The Name

- How can I know the difference?
 - Conviction or convenience? Acts 24:24ff; 1 Peter 3:15; cf. Daniel 3
 - Separated from the world? Romans 12:1-2; 1 John 2:15
 - Must "deny self ... and follow me." Matthew 16:24; John
 - Must develop the mind of a servant. Philippians 2:5; 4:8; Ephesians 2:1ff; Romans 6:16
 - Devoted to the church? Matthew 6:33; John 13:34; Hebrews 10:24-25
 - Appreciate strong preaching? Galatians 4:16; John 6:66
 - Growing? 2 Peter 1:5-11; 3:18
 - Trying to save the lost? John 15:1-8; Proverbs 11:30

Three Facts Regarding The Wearing Of The Name "Christian"

- Wear it voluntarily. cf. 2 Corinthians 12:15
- Wear it always. 1 Corinthians 15:58; Matthew 24:44; Luke 9:23 ... daily
- Wear it intelligently.
 - Influence. Matthew 5:13-16
 - Judgment. 2 Corinthians 5:10; Ecclesiastes 12:13

- Are we Christians or merely wearing the name?
- Not all who wear the name will go to heaven!
- Don't just wear the name, be the person that the name suggests, "Christ In You." cf. Galatians
 2:20
