The Invitation

- No eloquent or flowery oratory. 1 Corinthians 2:1
- Not "death bed tales and grave yard yarns." cf. Acts 2:37; 16:29-30; Acts 24:25
- Not determined by the "amens." Acts 7:51-53; 13:16-50

The Invitation

What, then, is the invitation?

- Peter told people what to do and why; and the consequences if they did not. (Acts 2:36-41 and Acts 3:13-26; cf. Mark 16:16; Acts 24:25).
- There is power (Romans 1:16) and terror (2 Corinthians 5:11) in the gospel.

The Invitation

What, then, is the invitation?

- Lead souls to respond to God's saving grace.
- Build faith in Christ and in his word.
- Convict men of sin and tell them of its remedy and retribution.
- Strongly urge them to obey the direct demands of obedience – faith, repentance, confession, and baptism (Acts 8:12,35-36; 16:32-33).
- Tell them what awaits them if they do not obey the truth (2 Thessalonians 1:8; Romans 2:6-9; 1 Peter 4:17-18).

The Invitation

What, then, is the invitation?

- Preach the truth.
- Press it into the hearts of men and lovingly insist that they obey it. Decision!
- God will give the increase, and you will be pure from the blood of all men.
