- Women who misrepresent the truth like Sapphira. Acts 5:1-10; cf. Proverbs 6:16; Ephesians 4:25; Colossians 3:9
- Women who look back like Lot's wife. Genesis 19:17-26; cf. Philippians 3:13-14; 2 Peter 2:20ff
- Women who are instigators of wickedness like Jezebel. 1 Kings 21; cf. 1 Timothy 2:12

Women NOT Needed In The Church

- Women who discourage their husbands like Job's wife. Job 2:9; cf. Prov. 21:9
- Women who tempt men to commit fornication like Jezebel of the New Testament. cf. Rev. 2:20; cf. Prov. 7; 2 Sam. 11; 1 Cor. 6:18
- Women who are quarrelsome like Euodias and Syntyche. Phil. 4:2; cf. Rom. 14:19; 1 Cor. 13:11; Rom. 12:3; Phil. 2:3-4; 2 Cor. 5:10; Mt. 5:9

- Women who are interested in teaching others like Priscilla. Acts 18:24-28

- Women who show hospitality like the Shunammite woman. 2 Kings 4; cf. Heb. 13:1-2
- Women who respect their husbands and are in subjection to them like Sarah. 1 Pet. 3:1-6; Eph. 5:22; Col. 3:18; Titus 2:5; Gen. 2:18
- Women who know how to get along like Naomi and Ruth. Ruth. 1:14; cf. John 13:34-35

- Women who are modest like Vashti.

I Tim. 2:9-10 Not This:

- Costly raiment.

- Be in subjection to own husbands.
- Meek and quiet spirit.

I Tim. 2:9-10 BUT THIS:

- Woman learn in subjection.
- Learn in quietness.
